

Nicolet National Forest

The Nicolet National Forest region encompasses the communities of Townsend, Lakewood, Mountain, Riverview and Doty in Oconto County, Wabeno and Carter in Forest County, and parts of Langlade and Marinette County. It's a place away from it all, with tranquil surroundings and natural beauty abundant with wildlife. The area has a tradition of hospitality, where you'll find ready smiles in all business establishments.

Wabeno

Wabeno was founded by early loggers and lumbermen. Visit the Wabeno Logging Museum and view the 1908 Phoenix Log Hauler, the only tracked locomotive of its kind still operational. Famous for its drinking water that originates from ancient glacial melt water, Wabeno bottles water at the source.

Carter

Visit the expanded Potawatomi Carter Casino • Hotel and the Indian Springs Lodge and Conference Center.

Townsend

This northern most Oconto County community is nestled along the Townsend Flowage, which is the second largest body of water in the county, hosts over a dozen community events and festivals including the annual 4th of July celebration.

Lakewood

Lakewood offers visitors recreational opportunities throughout the year. Cathedral Pines virgin timber, the historic Holt-Balcolm Lumber Camp, and unique shops and galleries adorn the crown of this community. Don't forget to add the annual Lions Arts and Crafts Fair to your summer calendar, held the first weekend in August.

Mountain

Swimming, camping and fishing in summer; ice fishing and snowmobiling in winter; and many events held at the Bill Lazansky Community Center.

Each season has its magic moments. The Nicolet National Forest provides abundant opportunities to witness the excitement of the changing seasons, diverse wildlife, and stunning vistas. Rushing streams, quiet lakes and a near wilderness setting will make your visit unforgettable.

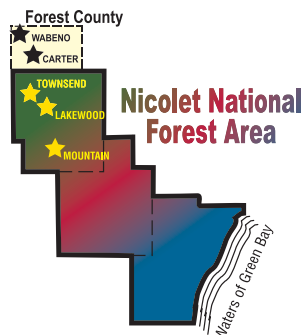

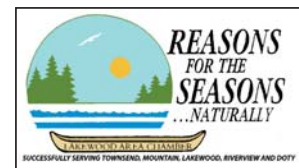
