Community Celebrations

Suring hosts a Labor Day weekend celebration. Activities include truck, tractor and ATV pulls, an antique car show, a buy-sell-swap on Main Street, quilt show, stage show, dancing, live music, children's activities and food!!!! The big parade on Labor Day, hosted by the Suring Lions Club, is a grand highlight of the weekend.

The 3rd Saturday in June, the Suring Area Business Association sponsors a huge Buy-Sell-Swap event along Highway 32 (Main Street).



Recreation Trail

A year-round recreation trail which was once a railroad grade, passes through the middle of the village. This trail offers access to the Oconto County and State trail systems. Hikers, bicyclist and horseback riders can follow the trail in all four seasons. ATV enthusiasts can ride from early May through October. During winter, enjoy snowmobiling along this well-groomed trail. Suring offers trail access just off Highway 32 (Main Street) where a parking and unloading area is located next to the Village Hall.



Oconto River/ Riverside Park

The Oconto River flows through the west side of town where the Riverside Memorial Park adorns its banks. The park has picnic facilities, a playground, gazebo, park benches and a community garden. If your wish is a fishing excursion or a canoe adventure a boat landing is available. If you're up for a walk, cross the iron bridge and stroll on the boardwalk through a river wetland and listen to frogs, birds and the "occasional" mosquito. The plants and wildlife in the wetland are an awesome display of nature's beauty and variety. Built-in benches along the walk offer the opportunity to meditate and escape in this haven of nature.

The Peshtigo Brook borders the Suring Community Park and creates a beautiful setting for family reunions and gatherings. This park is home to a baseball/softball field, playground, open-air shelter and food stands.

The Oconto River flows directly through the Village of Suring, on the west end of town. Just north of the Village of Suring, the north and south branches of the Oconto River converge; to create the main Oconto River. Other tributaries, such as the Peshtigo Brook and the Linzy Creek, also flow into the Oconto River.

The Oconto River offers the opportunity of sightseeing, canoeing, kayaking and fishing. An excellent recreation and picnic area, boat landing, walking bridge and nature boardwalk, are just some of the amenities the Oconto River has to offer.



Community Life

We hope you stop by the village's new Municipal Building, home of Suring Area Public Library, local government offices and a learning center. Check out the opportunities hosted here which include information center, children's play groups, story hours, classes, genealogy center, government and organizational meetings, support groups and much more, all coordinated by the local library and municipality. 2009 will be the start of historical and community art displays in the foyer of the building.
