The Public Beaches and Boat Landings

Swim or sun bathe at the east or west side beaches under the supervision of trained lifeguards during the long hot summer days. Fishermen can take advantage of the public boat landings and the opportunity to catch a lunker bass, northern or walleye. The Oconto River provides plenty of opportunity for fun in the sun and water activities!



Discover the Recreation

The Oconto Falls area offers a wide variety of excellent public recreational opportunities for all seasons. You will find well-maintained parks, playground facilities, and a local golf course. The flowage and channel of the Oconto River allow swimming, boating, canoeing, fishing, and water-skiing. The Machickanee County and Nicolet National Forests offer easy access to hunting, hiking, biking, cross country skiing, and snowmobiling.



The Winter Fun

Glide along miles of cross-country ski trails. Navigate your sled along the scenic well-groomed network of snowmobile trails. Hike or snowshoe in the nearby Machickanee County Forest. The snowy season does not mean you have to stay indoors! Oconto Falls can provide a cure for that cabin fever!



Discover the Arts

The opening of the Falls Area Performing Arts Center (PAC) has enriched the lives of the people of Oconto Falls by making the arts a vital part of our community.

The 764-seat facility provides an appropriate setting for music, drama, and the visual arts. It also serves as an outstanding venue for visiting performers and a Fine Arts Series. The Falls Area Performing Arts center is committed to making the arts accessible and affordable to all. You are invited to come often and experience a new level of enjoyment for the arts!



The Community Events and Festivals

In spring the Memorial Day festival offers a classic car show, carnival rides, softball and horseshoe tournaments and fun for the entire family. Falls Fun Fest takes place in September and boasts a firefighters water fight, fishing derby, pancake breakfast, walk/run and the state's largest city-wide rummage sale!



Discover the Educational Opportunities

Oconto Falls has an excellent K-12 school district including innovative distance learning programs. The community hosts the district's high school, middle school, one of several elementary schools and an alternative education center. In addition, there is a private elementary school available to residents. Northeast Wisconsin Technical College also offers courses in Oconto Falls at their Regional Learning Center.
