Leadership Oconto County (LOC) is dedicated to cultivating current and future leaders. Each year, a new class of business and community leaders are selected to spend nine months learning about the area, developing their leadership skills, and working on a class project to benefit local communities. Through the class project, class members will experience a hands-on, leadership-in-action component to the LOC program while providing a meaningful contribution to local communities.

We invite area organizations to submit potential projects for our participants to complete during their upcoming class year.

Potential Projects Should:

1. Fulfill a specific community need in Oconto County;
2. Be able to be completed between October 2021 and April 2022;
3. Need at least 5-10 participants;
4. Be a project your group would otherwise not have the resources to accomplish;
5. Be a project that once completed, your group will take over and manage in the future;
6. Not be purely fundraising, though the class may raise funds and materials for the project;
7. Include some aspect of development and research;
8. Have general liability insurance to which the LOC class can be added.

If your proposal is selected, we would expect your group to appoint a designated member to:

1. Represent the mission and vision of your organization to the class;
2. Communicate the need, scope, and concept of the project to the class;
3. Serve as the primary contact for the LOC class regarding the project;
4. Be available to attend several meetings with class members;
5. Participate in a press release to share the project with the community;
6. Be engaged with the class and available for phone calls and/or emails throughout the life of the project.

To submit your proposed project, please fill out and submit the attached application by Friday, July 20, 2021. Please provide as many details as possible in your application.

The LOC steering committee will review all requests and select finalists to present their project to the class in early Fall of 2021.
